

Idlewild Equestrian 2019 Barn Rules

1. All horses on the premises must have a current Coggins test (12 months) according to state law
2. Anyone wishing to ride must sign a current release form
3. ASTM approved riding helmets must be worn when riding
4. NO smoking in the stable vicinity, including the parking lot
5. No running or throwing objects in the barn OR around any horses
6. Young children must be closely monitored. No playing in the trailers behind the barn or with the jumps in the arenas without permission
7. When a lesson is being given, the instructor has control of the ring and others must abide by the instructor's direction
8. Children under 12 must have adult supervision
9. Children can be left under the supervision of staff if prior permission and arrangements are made
10. Jumping is not allowed without an instructor or instructor's permission. This rule does not apply to boarders over 18 who own their own horse
11. All boarders must keep the front of their stalls organized (tack trunks closed and clean; blankets on racks only during blanket season, and dusted off)
12. Boarder tack and boarder's personal items kept in the tack room must be kept neat, organized, and clean
13. Any pets must be on a leash
14. **All lesson horse tack (saddle, bridle, girth) must be cleaned and returned to its proper place**
15. Personal items left at the barn will be donated after 1 month
16. If you move any poles, standards, or other obstacles, put them back the way you found them when finished
17. Dispose of horse hair in the garbage can, not the muck bucket (it will not decompose)
18. We want to keep a clean barn and we need your cooperation. Keep the barn areas, wash areas, lounge areas, and arenas enjoyable for all. Wipe your feet where applicable and put all garbage in a trash can
19. If you opened it, shut it. If you turned it on, turn it off. Please help us conserve energy.
